

Koskalakas Service Award

Requirements for earning the Koskalakas Service Award are as follows:

- (A) The Nominee must have held Brotherhood membership for at least one (1) year, and must be an active member in good standing with both the Boy Scouts of America and Quapaw Lodge #160, Order of the Arrow.
- (B) The Nominee must be an active member of his local chapter, and must have attended at least 2/3 of his Chapter's meetings in the last two years.
- (C) The Nominee must have completed all requirements in either of the following categories:
 - a. Category A: The Nominee must complete BOTH portions of this Category.
 - i. The Nominee must have participated in $\frac{3}{4}$ of the Lodge's or Chapter's Team dances, over a period of two (2) years. The team must have performed at least five (5) dances during each year. The nominee must have participated in eight (8) dances during the two (2) year period.
 - ii. The Nominee must have a full dancer's outfit or have completed significant maintenance or rehabilitation on Chapter or Lodge outfits.
 - b. Category B: The Nominee must complete any three (3) of the five (5) portions of this category.
 - i. The Nominee must have attended one National or Sectional Conference of the Order of the Arrow, or two Quapaw Lodge Pilgrimages.
 - ii. The Nominee must have participated in Dance or Ceremony Competitions at either a National or Section Conference of the Order of the Arrow.
 - iii. The Nominee must have held, and have committed the part to memory, one of the following parts in a Lodge or Chapter Ceremony. (Remember, these are 3 of the 5 parts of this category. You can use all or part to get the 3 needed.)
 - 1. Any part in the Ordeal, Brotherhood, or Vigil Honor Ceremonies.
 - 2. The part of Allowat Sakima or Meteu in the Pre-Ordeal Ceremony.
 - 3. The part of Medicine Man or Dance Announcer of a Lodge or Chapter Dance Team.
- (D) The Nominee must have contributed substantial service to his Chapter or Lodge other than the service described in Numbers 1-4 above. Such service would include holding offices or committee chairmanships on either the Lodge or Chapter levels, attendance and unselfish service at Chapter or Lodge functions, etc.

Adult Nominees

- a. Adults may be recommended to the Service Award Committee by any member of the committee for outstanding service to the Lodge or Chapter. An application must have been completed by a Committee Member and presented to the Committee Chairman one month prior to the committee meeting.
- b. Requirements A, B, and two requirements from Category B must be met by all adults. Adults are to be measured by adult standards.

Koskalakas Service Award Patch

a. Recipients of the Koskalakas Service Award are entitled to only ONE patch, which they are strongly urged not to sell or trade. The patch must be purchased by the recipient. No one shall be allowed possession of the Koskalakas Service Award Patch unless he has been awarded the Koskalakas Service Award.
