BALOO Leader Training

BALOO Training is the “Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation” course for Cub Scout Camping. It is an entry level course to the outdoors and health and safety in the Boy Scouts of America. The more trained adults your unit has, the better your camp program will be.
