- ✓ Serve or have served as a Scout/Crew leader (Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor) for at least one year during the three-year period 2020 to 2023.
- ✓ MUST have a current BSA membership in a local Quapaw Area Council unit and be approved by the local council.
- ✓ All leaders regardless of assigned position MUST be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- ✓ Scoutmaster, First, Second or Third Assistant Scoutmasters MUST currently be serving in any unit leadership position.
- ✓ Scoutmaster applicants MUST have completed appropriate leader specific training.
- ✓ All adult leaders MUST be current with Youth Protection Training.
- ✓ All adults must register online through the Jamboree registration system as a “Leader”. The council will designate specific leadership or chaperone positions at the time the Jamboree units are assigned.
- ✓ Participate and assist in monthly Jamboree Committee planning meetings and the pre-Jamboree training experience with local council.
- ✓ Commit to recruit and retain a full 36-member troop for the Jamboree. This may entail making visits/presentations at district Roundtables, troop meetings, camporees, summer camp, etc.
- ✓ Have excellent organizational and communication skills to keep youth participants and their parents well informed in the months and weeks prior to Jamboree.
- ✓ Commit to attend the entire Jamboree and pre-Jamboree tour from Monday, July 17th through Saturday, July 29th 2023. Applications cannot be accepted for leaders who cannot commit to the entire Jamboree and pre-Jamboree tour.
- ✓ Commit to attending/leading at least 2 Jamboree troop/crew organizational meetings and Shakedown weekend (dates to be determined).
- ✓ Be able to meet Jamboree medical/physical requirements, including BMI requirements.
- ✓ Be approved and invited to serve by the Quapaw Area Council Jamboree Committee.
- ✓ Agree to pay the Council Jamboree Fee.
