

## **Donald W. Reynolds Scout Training Center**

### **Facility Description**

Located on a ridge overlooking a beautiful wooded valley on the 3200-acre Gus Blass Scout Reservation, the Donald W. Reynolds Scout Training Center is the premier location for training in the Boy Scouts of America Southern Region. The Reynolds Center is available for use by Scout Groups for National and Local Council and District Functions including Camp Schools, Order of the Arrow Training, Cub, Boy Scout and Venture Leader Training.

Available facilities include a 320 seat dining hall, commercial kitchen, 102 person sleeping wing, 2 ADA compliant rooms with private bathroom and shower, four separate group bathroom areas with showers, three separate meeting rooms, an intimate lobby area with a large fireplace, two large terraced patio areas and additional camping on adjacent Scout property.

### **Technology**

The Donald W. Reynolds Scout Training Center is equipped with state-of-the-art technology including;

- Wireless internet
- Wireless microphones for all rooms
- Satellite television
- Internal/External PA system
- Overhead projectors in all classrooms with laptop connections
- Flatscreen displays and/or televisions in dining hall and lobby

Priority use of the facility is for Scout Groups. Non-Scout groups wishing to use the facility will be required to complete a variety of forms which will include the following:

1. Letter of Agreement for Camp Use.
2. Organizational Hold Harmless Agreement.
3. Individual Hold Harmless Agreements from each participant.
4. Booking Sheet.

Non-Scout groups are also required to provide a \$2 million certificate of insurance naming the Quapaw Area Council Inc, Boy Scouts of America as an additional insured.

## LETTER OF AGREEMENT FOR CAMP USE

This letter of agreement is the purpose of establishing the use of the Gus Blass Scout Reservation / Donald W. Reynolds Scout Training Center by \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of \_\_\_\_\_ . This is a Boy Scout Camp and is used first and foremost by members of Boy Scouts of America.

2. Agrees to provide the Quapaw Area Council, Inc., with the following documents no less than 30 days prior to the above date stated.
  - a). A certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000 CSL (combined single limit) with the Quapaw Area Council, Inc., and the Boy Scouts of America, names as additional insured, ten (10) day written notice of cancellation, and the period of time involved.
  
  - b). An Organizational Hold Harmless Agreement.
  
  - c). A certificate showing non-profit and/or tax exempt status
  
  - d). A roster showing the names of all youth and adults participating in this activity. Each participant must provide a "Non Scouting Hold Harmless Agreement" which must be signed by an adult for those participants who are less than 18 years of age. **This form can be turned in at the beginning of the event.** Participants will not be allowed to stay on camp without a properly filled out and signed "Non Scouting Hold Harmless Agreement" form. This form does not apply to limo drivers.

3. Agrees to pay \$\_\_\_\_\_ for the use of the Gus Blass Scout Reservation which sum is payable to the Quapaw Area Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America.
4. A deposit of \$500.00 is required to be paid at the signing of this agreement. This is non-refundable, but is a part of the total fee.
5. Be responsible for any and all damages to camp property which may reasonably be attributed to the actions of the said group and agrees to promptly pay any and all reasonable damage claims when presented.
6. While Scouting makes every effort to accommodate all persons with disabilities, it is a charitable, private organization not subject to the ADA, and any group who uses the property is responsible for ADA compliance and any accommodations necessary for its participants and visitors.
7. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs of any kind are permitted to be used on the premises.
8. Agrees that you will provide at least one adult leader (defined as 21 years of age or older for purposes herein) for every ten (10) members of the party present in camp below the age of 21 years; that at least on the said adult leaders must be present with the group at all times while the groups is in camp.
9. Agrees that the group will abide by any and all of the camp operating rules and instructions of the Camp Ranger and/or Council Camping Director.
